NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Colchester Borough Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 31 March 2011 proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (1), 4(2), 32, 35,45,46,49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

EFFECT OF THE ORDER:

1 To introduce no waiting at any time in the following lengths of road

Ladyfields, Loughton	(i) North east side from its junction with Coulson Road for its entire length to its junction with Lushes Road (ii) North west side from a point opposite the eastern boundary of No. 45 to a point opposite the southern boundary of No. 24, a distance of approximately 28 metres (iii) Both sides from its junction with Borders Lane south for 10 metres (iv) From a point 10 metres north west of its junction with Ladyfields Close to a point 10 metres south east of that same point
Lushes Road, Loughton	(i) South side, from its junction with Ladyfields southwest for 7.3 metres
Borders Lane, Loughton	(i) From a point 10 metres north west of its junction with Ladyfields to a point 10 metres south east of that same point
Ladyfields Close, Loughton	(i) Both sides of its junction with Ladyfields north east for 29 metres
High Beech Road, Loughton	(i) Northwest side, from its junction with Forest View Road north west for 10 metres
Connaught Hill, Loughton	(i) Southeast side, from its junction with Forest View Road for 13 metres south east
Connaught Avenue	(i) Southwest side, from its junction with Forest View Road, southeast for 10 metres (ii) Northwest side, from its junction with Forest View Road, northwest for 10 metres (iii) Northeast side, from its junction with Forest View Road, Northwest for 10 metres

Statement of Reasons

The North Essex Parking Partnership proposes to make the above-named order following a review of the following roads in the Epping Forest district.

Forest View Road, Ladyfields, Connaught Avenue & High Beech Road

These restrictions are proposed to prevent danger to traffic and pedestrians and the likelihood of danger occurring.

The restrictions are also designed to prevent commuter parking and so improve the quality of life for residents.

Oakwood Hill

These restrictions are proposed to prevent danger to traffic and pedestrians and the likelihood of danger occurring and to help ensure the effective traffic flow of vehicles in the area.

Lushes Road, Ladyfield Close, Borders Lane and Connaught Hill

The restrictions are proposed to prevent danger to traffic and pedestrians and the likelihood of danger occurring
