

The Essex County Council (Braintree District) (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Amendment No.81) Order 201*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Colchester Borough Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 31 March 2011 proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (1), 4(2), 32, 35,45,46,49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the Order

1. To introduce no waiting at any time restrictions on the following lengths of road in the District of Braintree

Hayhouse Road-Earls Colne	Both sides from a point 1.5 metres north east from the north east facing boundary wall of Robins for a distance of 30.7 metres south west
Rifle Hill-Braintree	North side 24.0 metres east from the junction with Notley Road South side 21.8 metres east from the junction with Notley Road
Notley Road-Braintree	North east side 13.0 metres north west from the junction with Rifle Hill to a point 14.0 metres south east of the same junction
B1024 Feering Hill-Feering	South east side 15.5 metres south west from the junction with Kings Gardens to a point 15.8 metres north east of the same junction
Kings Gardens-Feering	Both sides 14.4 metres south east from the junction with Feering Hill
Janmead-Witham	Both sides 9.9 metres north east from the junction with Avenue Road
Avenue Road-Witham	North east side 13.4 metres south east from the junction with Janmead to a point 14.4 metres north west of the same junction South west side from a point level with the boundary of numbers 26 & 26a for a distance of 58.4 metres north west then south west

2. To revoke no waiting mon-fri 10am-11am on the following lengths of road in the District of Braintree

Avenue Road-Witham	North side, from a point in line with the western garden boundary wall of Number 58 Avenue Road, in a generally easterly direction to a point 30 metres northwest of its junction with Newland Street
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3. To revoke no waiting mon-fri 11am-12pm on the following lengths of road in the District of Braintree.

Avenue Road-Witham	South side, from a point in line with the western garden boundary wall of Number 58 Avenue Road, in a generally easterly direction to a point 30 metres northwest of its junction with Newland Street
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4. To introduce no waiting mon-fri 11am-12pm & 2pm-3pm on the following lengths of road in the District of Braintree.

Avenue Road-Witham	South west side 30.0 metres north west from the junction with Newland Drive to a point level with the boundary of numbers 26/26a South side from a point level with south west facing boundary wall of number 35 to a point level with the west facing boundary of No.58
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5. To introduce no waiting mon-fri 10-am-11am & 2pm-3pm on the following lengths of road in the District of Braintree.

Avenue Road-Witham	<p>North east side 30.0 metres north west from the junction with Newland Drive to a point 13.4 metres south east from the junction with Janmead</p> <p>North east side 14.4 metres north west from the junction with Janmead to a point level with the west facing boundary of No.58</p>
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6. To introduce no stopping mon-fri 8am-9.30am & 2.30pm-4pm on school entrance markings on the following lengths of road in the District of Braintree.

The Street-Pebmarsh Heron Road/Kingfisher Way-Kelvedon	<p>North side from the boundary of the Parish Hall/school for a distance of 71.0 metres east</p> <p>From a point level with the boundary of 1/3 Kingfisher Way to a point level with the boundary of 25/27 Heron Road</p>
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7. To introduce permit holders only mon-fri 10am-4pm (Zone K3) excluding bank and public holidays on the following length of road in the District of Braintree.

Kings Garden-Kelvedon	<p>Both sides 14.4 metres south east from the junction with Feering Hill for its entire length</p> <p>Numbers 1-11 Kings Garden, numbers 120, 120a and 122 Feering Hill will be entitled to apply for two resident permits and unlimited visitor permits. Full details of current permit prices can be obtained from the North Essex Parking Partnership.</p>
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This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Braintree District) (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Consolidation) Order 2008 by substituting tile numbers TL820 150 to revision 6, TL820 147 to revision 5, TL855 285 to revision 3, TL755 222 to revision 2, TL865 187 to revision 3, TL870 195 to revision 2, TL870 192 to revision 2 and by inserting new tile number TL855 335.
