

**The Essex County Council (Epping Forest District) (Special Parking and Permitted Parking Area) (Amendment No.5) Order 201\***

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** Colchester Borough Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 31 March 2011 proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (1), 4(2), 32, 35,45,46,49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

**Effect of the Order:**

1. To introduce no waiting at any time in the following lengths of road in the district of Epping Forest (add to schedule 1 of the 2016 order)

2. To revoke no waiting 9.30am to 6.30pm Monday to Friday restrictions and introduce pay and display parking between 9.30am and 6.30pm in the following lengths of road in the district of Epping Forest (remove from schedule 13 of the 2016 order and add to a new schedule 74 in the 2016 order)

5. To introduce Business Permit Holder (Zone OH1) and limited waiting 2 hours no return within 2 hours on the following length of roads in the district of Epping Forest (add to a new schedule 76 in the 2016 order)
