

**The District of Harlow (On Street) (Waiting, Loading and Parking)**  
**(Amendment No.11) Order 201\***

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** Colchester Borough Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 31 March 2011 proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (1), 4(2), 32, 35,45,46,49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

**Effect of the Order:** To introduce traders permits, virtual visitor permits, carer permits and partnership permits. Amendments also made to The District of Harlow (On Street) (Waiting, Loading and Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2011 (the 2011 Order`)

1. To introduce to Schedule 2 - Charges

2. To introduce to Part 1 Citation and Interpretation

<b>Insert definition</b>	<b>Insert new definition</b>
“Traders Permit”	“Traders Permit” means a parking permit for the benefit of bona fide traders with premises in the Harlow District to allow the authorised use of a permit parking bay between 8am and 5pm Monday to Saturday.
“Trader”	“Trader” means any tradesperson or business engaged in an activity that requires a vehicle for the purpose of carrying of tools, goods or materials to a number of different locations within a Permit Parking Place/Area or Zone
“Carer”	“Carer” means a person who provides care on a non-professional basis to a resident whose normal place of abode is within a Resident Permit Parking and who needs to be cared for by virtue of physical or mental infirmity
“Carer’s Permit”	“Carer’s Permit” means a discretionary permit issued by The Council to a Carer under the provisions of Part VI of the Order. Carer’s permits may be issued on approval by the North Essex Parking Partnerships Group Manager
“Partnership Permit”	“Parking Partnership Permit” means a permit issued to a local authority officer or contracted service provider to allow parking in a parking place, permit parking area or shared use bay (limited waiting and free permit) to allowing parking during the course of their duties
“Virtual Visitors Permit”	“Virtual Visitors Permit” means a Virtual Permit issued by a Service Provider. The Visitor Permit shall enable the driver of a vehicle who is the bona fide visitor of a Qualifying Resident to leave their vehicle in a Parking Place specified in the plans for either 6 hours or 24 hours depending on

	whether a 6 hour or 24 hour virtual visitor permit has been purchased

3. Part 1, Article 3 of `the 2011 Order` insert new definitions as follows

<b>Insert definition</b>	<b>Insert new definition</b>
Service Provider	means the contractor authorised by the council to accept payment of the parking charge on its behalf and to keep a record of that parking payment charge and the vehicle, parking place and parking period in respect of which payment has been made using the telephone or electronic payment system
“telephone or electronic payment system”	<p>“telephone or electronic payment system” means an electronic system, using a telephone connection or electronic application set up and maintained by the service provider whereby:</p> <p>(a) the driver of a vehicle, or some other person authorised by that driver on their behalf, uses a telephone or electronic device to communicate with the service provider and make payment of the parking charge in respect of a specified vehicle and parking place in which the vehicle is left and for a specified parking period by use of a credit or debit card; and</p> <p>(b) the service provider, on behalf of the Council, accepts payment of the parking charge by the method referred to in paragraph (a) of this definition and records such payment together with the parking period for which payment has been made, the parking place in which the vehicle is left and the registration mark of the vehicle in respect of which payment has been made</p>
Virtual Permit	“means a virtual resident’s permit, a virtual visitor permit, a virtual a virtual traders permit, a virtual carers permit or a virtual parking partnership permit
Virtual permit Holder	“means a person or company/organisation to whom a virtual permit has been issued in accordance with the provisions of the order”

The District of Harlow (On Street) (Permitted Parking Area & Special Parking Area) (Consolidation) Order 2011 will be varied by the above Order.
