

**The Essex County Council (Braintree District) (Permitted Parking and Special Parking Area)(Consolidation) (Amendment No.75) Order 201\***

**Statement of Reasons**

**Elizabeth/Pelly/Pitt Avenue-Witham**

The permanent order is required to keep the roads free of parked vehicles where any parking is considered to be a hindrance to traffic flow and bus access. The order will also serve to improve and preserve the amenities of the area through which the roads run. Removing parked vehicles will also improve safety and reduce the probability of road traffic accidents and promote access to larger vehicles such as refuse freighters, buses and those associated with the emergency services particularly at junctions.

**Warley Close-Braintree**

The permanent order is required to keep the roads free of parked vehicles where any parking is considered to be a hindrance to traffic flow and safe access. The order will also serve to improve and preserve the amenities of the area through which the roads run. Removing parked vehicles will also improve safety and reduce the probability of road traffic accidents and promote access to larger vehicles such as refuse freighters and those associated with the emergency services particularly at the junction.

**Notley Green/Ragley Close-Great Notley**

The permanent order is required to keep the roads free of parked vehicles where any parking is considered to be a hindrance to traffic flow, particularly buses and delivery vehicles. The order will also serve to improve and preserve the amenities of the area through which the roads run. Removing parked vehicles will also improve safety and reduce the probability of road traffic accidents and promote access to larger vehicles such as refuse freighters and those associated with the emergency services particularly at the junctions.

Providing an element of time limited parking will also discourage all day parking and promote customer visits to local amenities.
