

**The Essex County Council (Braintree District) (Permitted Parking and Special Parking Area) (Consolidation) (Amendment No.81) Order 201\***

**Statement of Reasons**

**Avenue Road/Janmead -Witham**

The permanent order is required to keep the road and junctions free of parked vehicles for a majority of the day where it is considered that all day parking, associated with the nearby railway station and local businesses impedes the access of large vehicles and the safe passage of motorists. Removing parked vehicles at the Janmead junction will also improve safety and reduce the probability of road traffic accidents.

**Rifle Hill/Notley Road-Braintree**

The permanent order is required to keep the road free of parked vehicles where any parking is considered to be a hindrance to traffic flow and access. The order will also serve to improve and preserve the amenities of the area through which the road runs. Removing parked vehicles will also improve safety and reduce the probability of road traffic accidents and promote access to larger vehicles such as refuse freighters and those associated with the emergency services.

**Kings Gardens-Kelvedon**

A parking scheme will improve the parking provision for local residents and their visitors by preventing non-residents from parking during the stipulated times.

**Hayhouse Road-Earls Colne**

The permanent order is required to keep the road free of parked vehicles where it is considered that any parking is inappropriate and likely to severely impede the access of large vehicles such as articulated lorries.

**The Street-Pebmarsh**

The order is required to keep the frontage of the school free of parked vehicles where any parking is considered to be a hindrance to access & pupil safety. Removing parked vehicles will also improve safety and reduce the probability of road traffic accidents and promote access to larger vehicles, if required.

**Kingfisher Way/Heron Road-Kelvedon**

The order is required to keep the rear entrance of the school free of parked vehicles where any parking is considered to be a hindrance to access & pupil safety. Removing parked vehicles will also improve safety and reduce the probability of road traffic accidents.
