

The Essex County Council (Colchester Borough) (Permitted Parking and Special Parking Area) (Amendment No 18) Order 201X

Statement of Reasons

Leys Road-Wivenhoe

Double yellow lines will ensure that access and vision is un-obscured at key points, primarily the service entrance to local shops. The provision of yellow lines will also reduce the probability of road traffic accidents by removing any potential obstructions to larger vehicles.

Rotary Way-Colchester

Nominal double yellow lines will ensure that access in the area is maintained particularly in relation to larger vehicles including those associated with the emergency services.

Head Street-Rowhedge

Nominal double yellow lines will ensure that access and vision is un-obscured at key points, primarily close to the Doctors Surgery entrance. The provision of yellow lines will also reduce the probability of road traffic accidents.

Taylors Road & Colne Rise-Rowhedge

Double yellow lines will ensure that access and vision is un-obscured at key points, such as junctions. The provision of yellow lines will also reduce the probability of road traffic accidents and aid larger vehicle access.

Sanders Drive-Colchester

A nominal double yellow line, already in place, via a temporary order will ensure that access and vision is un-obscured at key points, such as the junction. The provision of yellow lines will also reduce the probability of road traffic accidents and aid larger vehicle access.

Upland Drive-Colchester

A nominal double yellow line, already in place, via a temporary order will ensure that access and vision is un-obscured at key points, such as the junction. The provision of yellow lines will also reduce the probability of road traffic accidents and aid larger vehicle access.
