

**The Essex County Council (Epping Forest District) (Permitted Parking and Special
Parking Area) (Consolidation) (Amendment No.9) Order 201***

Statement of Reasons

Smarts Lane/Forest Road/High Beech Road/Nursery Road

A resident parking scheme will improve the parking provision for local residents and their visitors, with spaces often assumed by non-residents associated with the nearby tube station and town. The introduction of nominal double yellow lines will serve to enhance the sight lines in the vicinity to improve safety and access. Limited waiting bays will also provide customers with an opportunity to utilise an element of free parking encouraging footfall to the nearby businesses.

Kings Green-Loughton

The road is within a short walking distance of a tube station and town and is regularly utilised by non residents for parking. A resident parking will improve the parking provision for local residents and their visitors. Dual use of the bay will also be encouraged to offer shoppers parking spaces during specified times, when bays use is limited, to visit local shops and businesses.

Allnutts Road/Charles Street/Brook Road/Crossing Road/Warren Field-Epping

The roads are within a short walking distance of a tube station and is regularly utilised by non-residents for parking. A resident parking scheme will improve the parking provision for local residents and their visitors. The provision of yellow lines will also reduce the probability of road traffic accidents and allow larger vehicles such as those associated with the emergency services and refuse collection, unhindered access.
