Myland: High Woods Country Park. Lexden: London Road car park. Dedham: Mill Lane car and lorry park & Mill Pond car park. West Mersea: Victoria Esplanade, Willoughby Park, Seaview Avenue, Coast Road & High Street car parks. Wivenhoe: Cooks Yard A car park, Cooks Yard B car park and High Street car park.

Town Hall Car Park

Clarification on the area covered by the Off-Street order is being made to ensure that the off-street areas next off St Runwald Street are covered by the car park restrictions. Vehicles parking in turning areas and out of bay have caused traffic flow issues and the change will allow patrols and enforcement of these areas

Osborne Street Surface Car Park
