

The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Permitted Parking and Special Parking Area) (Consolidation) (Amendment No.65) Order 20**

Statement of Reasons.

Priors Wood Road-Takeley

The introduction of waiting and loading restrictions is deemed to be required due to obstructive parking which occurs at site, and the removal of parking will provide greater access to all motorists and drivers of larger vehicles, including refuse freighters and those associated with the emergency services.

Wintershutt Road/Roding Drive-Takeley

The permanent order is required to keep the road free of parked vehicles where any parking is considered to be a hindrance to access and safety, improving visibility.

A1060/B183 & Matching Road-Hatfield Heath

The permanent order is required to keep the road and junctions free of parked vehicles where any parking is considered to be a hindrance to access. The order will also serve to improve and preserve the amenities of the area through which the road runs. Removing parked vehicles will also improve safety and reduce the probability of road traffic accidents and promote access to larger vehicles, if required.

Long Hide/Dunmow Road-Leaden Roding

The permanent order is required to keep the road free of parked vehicles where any parking is considered to be a hindrance to access and safety, improving visibility.

Elm Close-Takeley

The permanent order is required to keep the road and free of parked vehicles where any long term parking, often associated with the nearby airport is considered to be a hindrance to access. The order will also serve to improve and preserve the amenities of the area through which the road runs. Removing parked vehicles will also improve safety and reduce the probability of road traffic accidents and promote access to larger vehicles, if required.
