

**The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area)(Consolidation)(Amendment No.67) Order 201\***

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** Colchester Borough Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 31 March 2011 proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (1), 4(2), 32, 35,45,46,49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

**EFFECT OF THE ORDER:**

To introduce resident permit holders only at any time (Zone CP1) on the following lengths of road in the District of Tendring

<b>Road</b>	<b>Description</b>
Chapman Road, Clacton on Sea	i) South west side, from a point 14 metres north west of its junction with High Street, north west for 196.8 metres ii) North east side, from a point 14 metres north west of its junction with High Street, north west for 28.7 metres iii) North east side, from a point 42.7 metres north west of its junction with High Street, north west for 247.5 metres

All residential properties on Chapman Road will be entitled to apply for up to two resident permits. Visitor permits are also available. Charges apply for both resident and visitor permits. Further details are available on the NEPP website at the below address:
