

The Essex County Council (Braintree District) (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Amendment No.71) Order 201*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Colchester Borough Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 31 March 2011 proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (1), 4(2), 32, 35,45,46,49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the Order

- 1- To introduce no waiting at any time restrictions on the following lengths of road in the District of Braintree

Guithavon Valley, Witham	i)	North west side from a point 35 metres south west of its junction with Armond Road south west for 14.8 metres
	ii)	North west side from a point 63.8 metres south west of its junction with Armond Road south west for a distance of approximately 167.0 metres
	i)	South east side from a point 15.0 metres south west from its junction with Armond Road south west for a distance of 217.0 metres
Mill Lane, Witham	i)	South west side from its junction with Guithavon Road south east for 180 metres
	ii)	North west side from a point 15 metres southwest of its junction with Armond Road south west for 19.7 metres

2. To revoke no waiting Mon-Sat 8am-7pm
