

The Essex County Council (Epping Forest District) (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Amendment No.30) Order 20**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Colchester Borough Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 31 March 2011 proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (1), 4(2), 32, 35,45,46,49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the Order: To introduce traffic regulation orders to restrict waiting in those lengths of road described below and to prevent commuter parking and therefore allow residents and their visitors to park along Western Avenue. Amendments also made to The Order 2008 to remove obsolete definitions and further clarify some existing restrictions.

1. To introduce limited waiting 30 minutes no return within 2 hours

Road	Description
London Road, North Weald Bassett	North West side, from a point approximately 70 metres north east from the entrance of residential property "Rundells" north east for 156 metres

2. To introduce no waiting at any time

Road	Description
London Road, North Weald Bassett (North-East leg)	Both sides from its junction with the B1393 for its entire length.
Western Avenue, Epping	North side from a point 10 metres from its southern junction with Centre Drive west and then north for 83 metres
Western Avenue, Epping	South side from a point 10 metres from its northern junction with Centre Drive west and then south for 43.8 metres

3. To introduce resident permit holders only at any time

Road	Description
London Road, North Weald Bassett (South-West leg)	Both sides from its junction with the B1393 east for its entire length. The residents of the following properties may apply for a resident permit: 1-5 London Road, North Weald Bassett

4. To introduce resident permit holders only 10am to 4pm Monday to Friday

Road	Description
Western Avenue, Epping	South side from a point 10 metres from its southern junction with Centre Drive to a point 9.5 metres from its northern junction with Centre Drive. The residents of all properties in Western Avenue will be eligible to apply for a permit.
Western Avenue, Epping	North Side from a point 10 metres from its southern junction with Centre Drive to a point to a point 43 metres from its northern junction with Centre Drive The residents of all properties in Western Avenue will be eligible to apply for a permit

The Council shall set a charge for the issue of such notices as it considers appropriate”

3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by any other enactment

(i) North West side from a point approximately 70 metres north east from the entrance of residential property "Rundells" north east for 156 metres

2 To introduce no waiting at any time (existing restrictions contained within schedule 1 of the 2008 Order)

London Road – North Weald Bassett

(i) Both sides from its junction with the B1393 from its entire length

Western Avenue – Epping

(i) North side from a point 10 metres from its southern junction with Centre Drive west and then north for 83 metres

(ii) South side from a point 10 metres from its northern junction with Centre Drive west and then south for 43.8 metres

3 To introduce resident permit holders only at any time (introduces a new schedule 14 (a) to the 2008 Order)

London Road, North Weald Bassett (South West Leg)

(i) Both sides from its junction with the B1393 east for its entire length.

The residents of 1-5 London Road North Weald Bassett may apply for a permit

4 To introduce resident permit holders only 10am to 4pm Monday to Friday (existing restrictions contained within Schedule 42 of the 2008 Order)

Western Avenue Epping

(i) South side from a point 10 metres from its southern junction with Centre Drive to a point 9.5 metres from its northern junction with Centre Drive

(ii) North side from a point 10 metres from its southern junction with Centre Drive to a point 43 metres from its northern junction with Centre Drive.

The residents of all properties in Western Avenue Epping will be able to apply for a permit

Statement of Reasons

The North Essex Parking Partnership proposes to make the above-named order following a review of the following roads in the Epping Forest District

London Road North Weald Bassett

Residents permit parking is being introduced to prevent commuter parking and so ease parking problems for residents. No waiting at any time is being introduced to the north-east leg of London Road to avoid danger to persons and traffic and the likelihood of such danger occurring near to the County Council depot

Western Avenue Epping

Residents permit parking is being introduced to prevent commuter parking and so ease parking problems for residents. No waiting at any time is being introduced to avoid danger to persons and traffic and the likelihood of such danger occurring near to junctions and bends in the carriageway

Amendments to the 2008 Order are also being made to remove obsolete definitions and clarify some existing restrictions
