

The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Permitted Parking and Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. 32) Order 20XX

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Colchester Borough Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 31 March 2011 proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (1), 4(2), 32, 35,45,46,49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

EFFECT OF THE ORDER:

1. To revoke Monday – Saturday 8am -9pm Resident permit holders only (Zone A) restrictions and introduce Monday – Saturday 8am – 9pm Resident Permit Holders only (Zone A) restrictions in the following length of roads and limited waiting 1 hour no return within 4 hours between 8am – 9pm Monday to Saturday in the following lengths of road

Road	Description
Lower Street, Stansted Mountfitchet	<p>East side</p> <p>(i) from a point 52 metres north of its junction with Grove Hill northwards for a distance of approximately 49 metres</p> <p>(ii) from a point 22 metres north-east of its junction with High Lane north eastwards for a distance of 7 metres</p> <p>(iii) from a point approximately 33.6 metres north-east of its junction with High Lane north eastwards for a distance of approximately 33 metres</p> <p>West Side</p> <p>(i) from a point 29 metres north of its junction with Grove Hill northwards for a total distance of approximately 82 metres</p> <p>(ii) from its junction with High Lane north-eastwards for a total distance of approximately 25 metres</p> <p>The following residents of Lower Street may apply for a permit 3 - 61 + 63 (odd numbers only) 42 – 56 + 58 (Dog and Duck Public House) 60-76 even</p>

2. To revoke no waiting 9am – 6pm Monday to Friday and replace with no waiting at any time in the following length of road

Road	Description
Lower Street, Stansted Mountfitchet	2 metres south of the northern boundary of number 27 south for a distance of 26 metres

3. To revoke no waiting Monday – Saturday 8am to 6pm and introduce no waiting at any time in the following length of road

Road	Description
High Street, Great Dunmow	West side from a point 22 metres north of Haslers Lane south for 22 metres

4. To introduce resident permit holders only in the following length of road (Zone B)

Road	Description
High Street, Great Dunmow	West side from a point 22 metres north of Haslers Lane north for 44 metres. The following residents of High Street may apply for a permit 82 – 106 (even numbers only)

5. To Introduce Clearway (no stopping at any time) restrictions in the following length of road

Road	Description
Audley End Road, Saffron Walden	Both sides from a point 30 metres north west of its junction with Wenden Road for a distance of 582 metres in a north western direction

6. To introduce no stopping on school entrance markings between 8.30am to 9.30am and 3pm to 4pm Monday to Friday in the following length of road

Road	Description
High Stile, Great Dunmow	East side from the northern boundary of St Marys primary school south for 25.6 metres East side from a point 46.9 metres from the northern boundary of St Marys primary school south for 33 metres West side from a point opposite the northern boundary of St Marys primary school south for 51.5 metres

7. Part 1, Article 2 of 'the 2008 Order' – delete definition of the following definitions and insert new definition as follows:

Delete definition	Insert new definition
"Visitors Permit"	"Visitors Permit" means a resident's visitors parking card validated by removing the silver coating to identify the date, month and year of use and by completing the relevant information boxes on the permit to indicate the address that the driver of the vehicle is visiting and the time that the vehicle was left in the parking place
"Parking Permit"	"Parking Permit" means a device or virtual device issued by The Council

	under the provisions of this Order to allow the authorised use of a Parking Place, subject to the provisions of this Order
"The Council"	"The Council" means The North Essex Parking Partnership

8. Part 1, Article 2 of `the 2008 Order` insert new definition as follows

Insert definition	Insert new definition
"Business Waiver Certificate"	"Business Waiver Certificate" means a parking permit for the benefit of bona fide traders with premises in the Uttlesford district to allow the authorised use of a permit parking bay or limited waiting bay

9. Part 3 , Article 19 (b) of `the 2008 Order` - to be deleted and replaced with "Visitor's Permits: A Qualifying Resident may apply to The Council for a maximum of twenty Visitors Permits during one transaction"
10. Part 3, Article 19 of `the 2008 order` insert new definition as follows "(C) Business Waiver Certificate: A qualifying business may apply to The Council for a Business Waiver Certificate. The Council may require that proof of trading is provided before a Waiver Certificate is issued"
11. Part 3, Article 23 of `the 2008 Order` to be deleted and replaced with "A separate application (with fee) must be made by a Qualifying Resident for each Vehicle at an address. A maximum of two resident permits may be issued per qualifying property"
12. Part 3, Article 30 to be deleted and replaced with "A Visitors Permit shall be produced by The Council only and shall make provision for the date and time which the Vehicle was left in the Parking Place. A Visitor Permit is only valid for 24 hours from the time of arrival as recorded by the driver on the visitor permit. If no time or date is recorded or is not visible on the Visitors Permit when it is checked by a Civil Enforcement Officer the Visitor Permit will not be valid. The Visitors Permit will not be valid if the address box is not completed.
13. Part 3, Article 37 of `the 2008 Order` to be deleted
14. Part 3, Article 39 of `the 2008 Order` to be deleted and replaced with "Each valid Visitor Permit shall enable the Driver of a Vehicle who is a bona fide visitor of a Qualifying Resident to leave their vehicle in a Parking Place specified in the plans for a maximum period of 24 hours"
15. Part 4, Article 81 of `the 2008 Order` to be deleted
16. Schedule 1 (1) of `the 2008 Order` to be deleted and replaced with "The charge in connection with the issue of a first residents' permit for the leaving of a vehicle in any parking place during the permitted hours shall, subject to hereinafter provided, be £70
17. Schedule 1 (2) of the `2008 Order` to be deleted and replaced with "The charge in connection with the issue of a second residents' permit for the leaving of a vehicle in any parking place during the permitted hours shall, subject to hereinafter provided, be £100.
18. Schedule 1 (a) of `the 2008 Order` to be deleted and replaced with "£10 for 10 x Visitor Permits
19. Schedule 1 (b) of `the 2008 Order` to be deleted
20. Schedule 1 of `the 2008 Order` insert the following "Business Waiver Certificate: (1) The Charge in connection with the issue of a Business Waiver Certificate for the leaving of a vehicle in any parking place during the permitted hours shall be £90 for the period of 3 months, £175 for the period of 6 months and £300 for the period of 12 months.

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Consolidation) Order 2008 by replacing tile numbers TL625 215 with revision 04, TL510 247 with revision 02, TL515 250 with revision 01, TL620 217 with revision 04, TL530 377 with revision 02 and inserting tile numbers TL525 377 and TL525 380.
