

The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Amendment No. 60) Order 201*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Colchester Borough Council acting on behalf of the North Essex Parking Partnership in exercise of the delegated powers of the traffic authority Essex County Council granted under an Agreement dated 31 March 2011 proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4 (1), 4(2), 32, 35,45,46,49 and 53 and Parts III and IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the Order

1. To revoke no waiting and no loading between 8am and 6.30pm Monday to Friday and Ambulance parking only on Saturdays and introduce limited waiting 2 hours no return within 2 hours Monday to Saturday 8am to 8pm and no stopping except Ambulances on Saturdays in the following lengths of road in the District of Uttlesford

Road	Description
Audley Road, Saffron Walden	i) South side from a point 27.6 metres from its junction with Station Road west for 9 metres

2. To revoke no waiting and no loading 8am and 6.30pm Monday to Friday and Limited waiting 2 hours no return within 2 hours on Saturdays and introduce limited waiting 2 hours no return within 2 hours Monday to Saturday 8am to 8pm in the following lengths of road in the District of Uttlesford

Road	Description
Audley Road, Saffron Walden	i) South side from a point 13.8 metres from its junction with Station Road west for 13.8 metres
	ii) South side from a point 36.6 metres from its junction with Station Road west for 18.0 metres

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Consolidation) Order 2008 by substituting the following tile numbers, TL535 380 revision 3 with revision 4
