## Notice of Intention

### Uttlesford District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2017

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the District Council intends under powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to make the Uttlesford District Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2017 which provides as follows:

- 1 The Uttlesford District (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2017 (“the Order”) replaces the Uttlesford District (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2008 (“the Original Order”).
- 2 The Original Order is to be revoked.
- 3 The Order relates to the following Parking Places:

**Great Dunmow:** Angel Lane, Chequers Lane, White Street, Great Dunmow Council Offices (New Street) A, Great Dunmow Council Offices (New Street) B **Saffron Walden:** Rose and Crown, Catons Lane, Fairycroft Road car park, The Common, Swan Meadow coach and car park, Saffron Walden Council Offices **Stansted Mountfitchet:** Lower Street Coach and car park, Crafton Green **Thaxted:** Margaret Street

- 4 The general effect of the Order is as follows:
  - a. To amend parking charge time of operation to 8am – 5pm Monday to Saturday in all pay and display car parks
  - b. To increase the maximum stay time in The Common car park from 2 hours to 3 hours. Tariffs to be as below:

Stay Period	Up to 30 mins	Up to 1 hour	Up to 2 hours	Up to 3 hours

- c. To amend the Order wording in relation to disabled badge holder parking to the below:

“A disabled person’s vehicle may wait in a parking place without payment on any particular day if the vehicle is displaying in the relevant position a valid disabled persons badge, and the disc, and the vehicle immediately before use, or after the act of parking, has been driven or used or is about to be driven or used by the person to whom the badge has been issued or, as the case may be, used for the carrying of disabled person(s) or passenger(s)”
    - d. Following the redesign of Lower Street car park Stansted Mountfitchet, to introduce a revised tariff structure and parking bays for specified users as shown below:

Yearly season ticket prices will be £620 per year (previously £420) or £320 for 6 months (previously £220).

e. To amend the Order to allow motorhomes, campervans and recreational vehicles to take up two parking spaces in Swan Meadow car park if two valid parking tickets are purchased and displayed in the vehicle.
